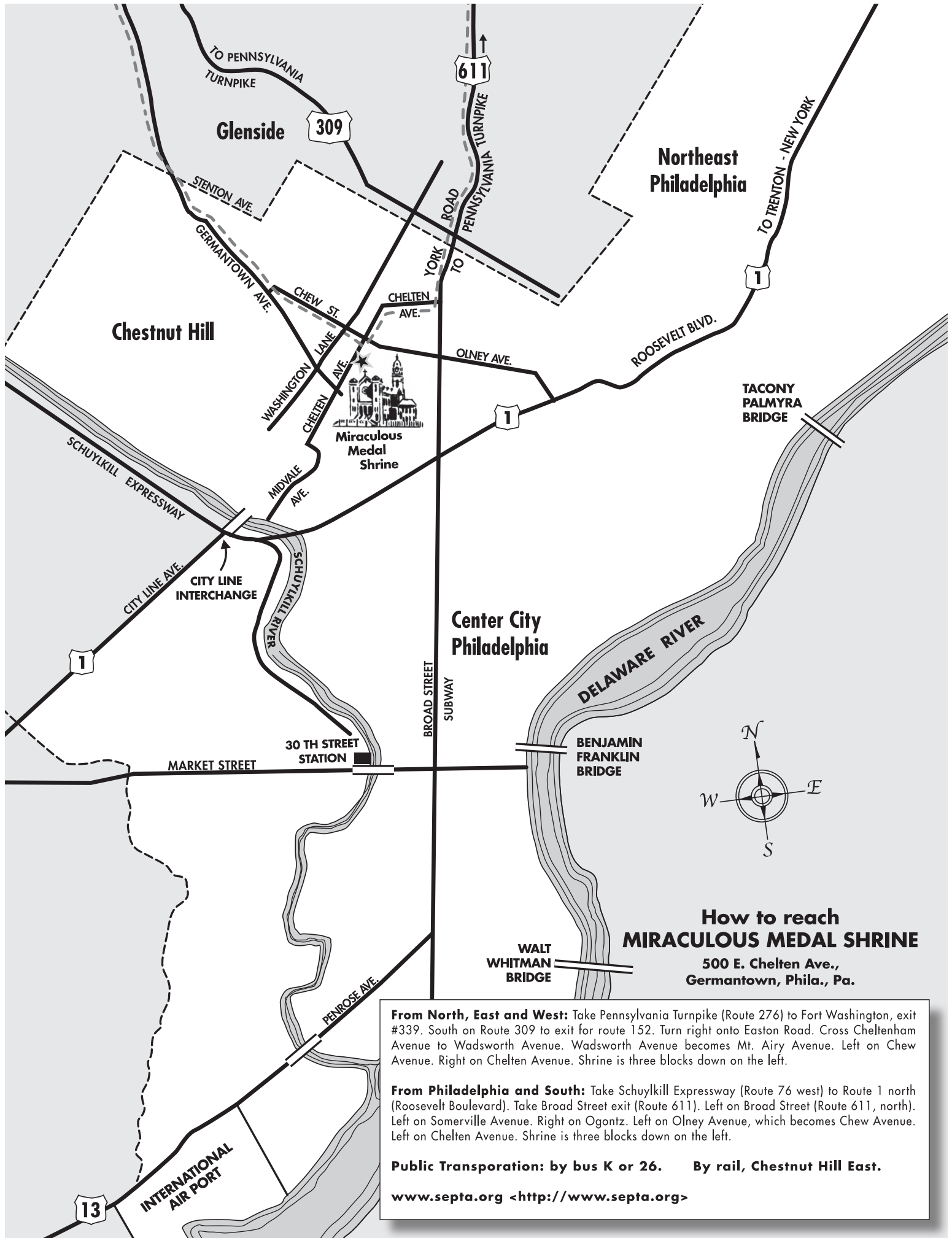

**How to reach
MIRACULOUS MEDAL SHRINE**

**500 E. Cheltenham Ave.,
Germantown, Phila., Pa.**

From North, East and West: Take Pennsylvania Turnpike (Route 276) to Fort Washington, exit #339. South on Route 309 to exit for route 152. Turn right onto Easton Road. Cross Cheltenham Avenue to Wadsworth Avenue. Wadsworth Avenue becomes Mt. Airy Avenue. Left on Chew Avenue. Right on Cheltenham Avenue. Shrine is three blocks down on the left.

From Philadelphia and South: Take Schuylkill Expressway (Route 76 west) to Route 1 north (Roosevelt Boulevard). Take Broad Street exit (Route 611). Left on Broad Street (Route 611, north). Left on Somerville Avenue. Right on Ogontz. Left on Olney Avenue, which becomes Chew Avenue. Left on Cheltenham Avenue. Shrine is three blocks down on the left.

Public Transportation: by bus K or 26. By rail, Chestnut Hill East.
